\* The AFUE (Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency) of proposed new equipment can be found at [www.ahridirectory.org](http://www.ahridirectory.org) or [www.energystar.gov/products](http://www.energystar.gov/products). The EF (Efficiency Factor) for water heaters is based on the amount of hot water produced per unit of fuel consumed over a typical day. A higher AFUE or EF indicates more efficient equipment.

2. **Complete the rebate application and include the contractor's final invoice. An application may be submitted online at [vermontgas.com](http://vermontgas.com)**
3. **Once 1 & 2 have been completed, we will issue a rebate check directly to the homeowner.**

- VGS reserves the right to verify the eligibility of the equipment installed. Customers must provide the Contractor's final invoice with rebate application to VGS for payment. Contractor's invoice must include size, make, model and serial number of the installed equipment.
- Incomplete rebate applications, missing data, or ineligible equipment may result in the delay or disqualification of the rebate.
- Rebate requests must be submitted within four weeks of the completed installation of equipment.
