

# IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING UPCOMING RATE CHANGES

For over 50 years, VGS has maintained competitive and affordable rates for its 54,000+ customers. As we work to enhance our customer service and make investments in safety and Vermont’s clean energy future, we are committed to keeping those rates low for current and future customers.

We want to let you know about a couple of upcoming rate changes that you will see on your February bill affecting the Natural Gas Charge and Energy Efficiency Utility (“EEU”) Charge. Each of these changes is described below.

First, subject to regulatory approval, the Natural Gas Charge component of your bill is increasing by 11.6%, effective with bills rendered on and after February 1, 2022. VGS adjusts the Natural Gas Charge portion of your bill quarterly, up or down, in response to changes in the cost of gas. This change in the Natural Gas Charge is driven by an increase in natural gas commodity prices. The effect of this change on your bill will vary depending on your natural gas usage but, on average, is equivalent to an overall increase of 4.0%.

Second, the Vermont Public Utility Commission has approved an increase in the EEU Charge. The EEU Charge is used to fund the wide range of energy efficiency programs VGS offers its customers. The EEU Charge will increase by about 3.8%.

If the Natural Gas Charge is approved, the rate components will be adjusted as follows:
